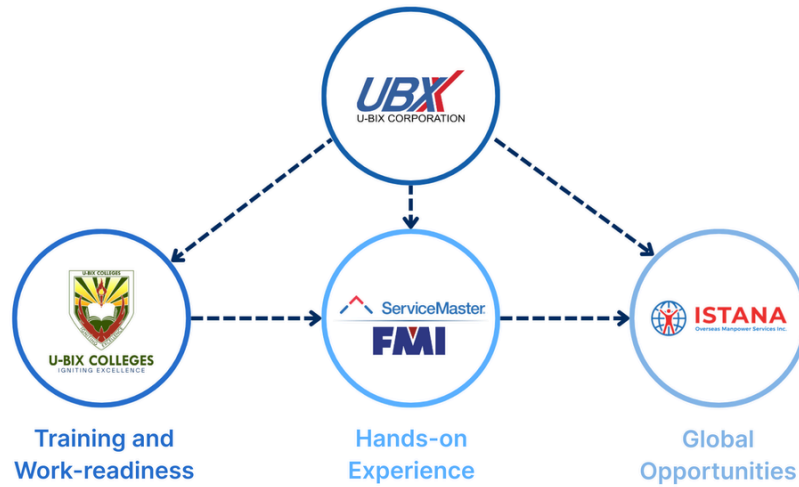

At the Hannover industrial fair in 1973, Chairman Bravo discovered the U-BIX Mark 1 copier—then considered revolutionary for its ability to print on any paper—and sought to bring it to the Philippines. Distribution rights depended on Mitsubishi Corporation's General Manager in Manila, Mr. Shinroku Morohashi, who—despite initial doubts that a new player could compete with Xerox—chose to place his trust in Mr. Bravo. That decision led to the founding of U-BIX Corporation on January 2, 1974, and to what is widely regarded as one of the longest and most enduring Japanese-Filipino business partnerships—the 50-year alliance between U-BIX and Konica Minolta.

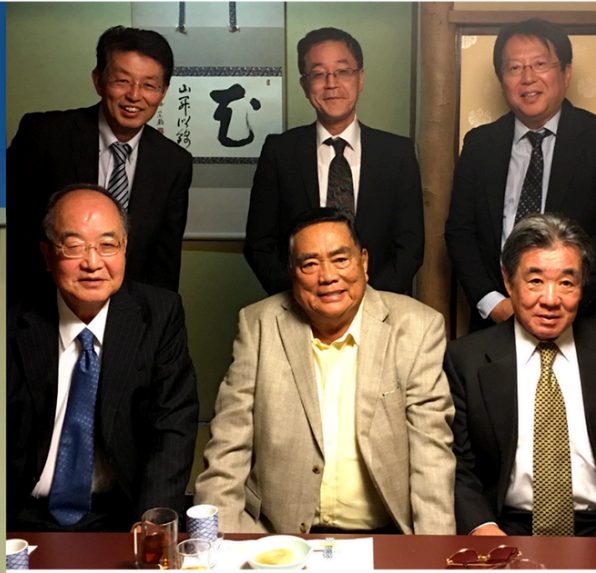


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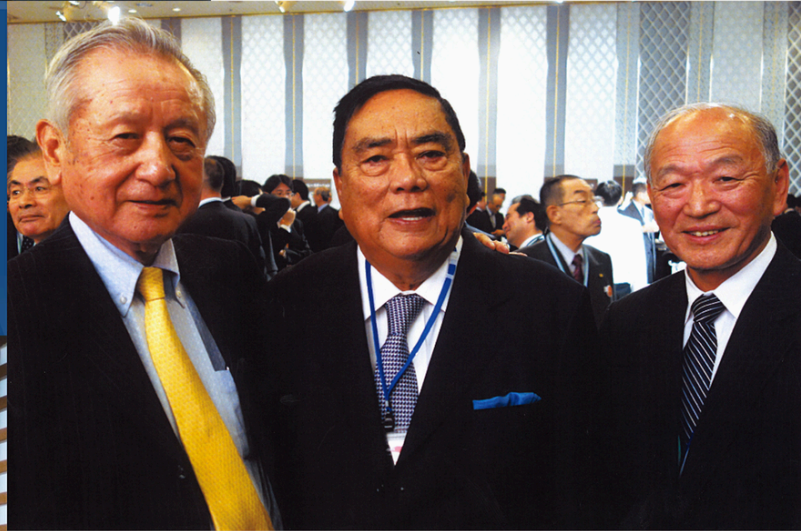

LEADING copier and printer provider U-Bix Corporation (U-Bix) has announced that the purchase of the Kodak Imaging Center (KIC) Philippines business from Kodak Philippines Limited.

U-Bix has acquired the entire KIC Philippines business, including document and microfilm scanning, database creation and management, encoding and data entry, and essential mail printing.

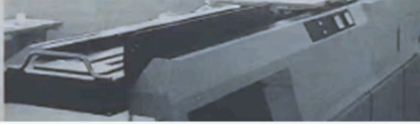
U-Bix will serve existing KIC customers with the same qualified and experienced team and resources, providing uninterrupted service to existing customers.

"The Philippines has been an important market to Kodak, and to BPS (Business Process Services), which manages KIC operations in the region. In the new Kodak operating model, we determined that customers would be best served by a local company with a dedica-

dedication to its workers will remain as a strong foundation in order to continue its momentum to provide services to its customers.

"In buying the KIC operations of Kodak Philippines Ltd., we purchased not only its physical assets but also, we retained the services of all the key managers with a combined experience of more than 40 years.
